**Description:** Superstition Ridgeline Trail is a 10.7 mile lightly trafficked point-to-point trail located near Apache Junction, Arizona that features beautiful wild flowers and is rated as difficult. The trail is primarily used for hiking, walking, nature trips, and birding and is accessible year-round.

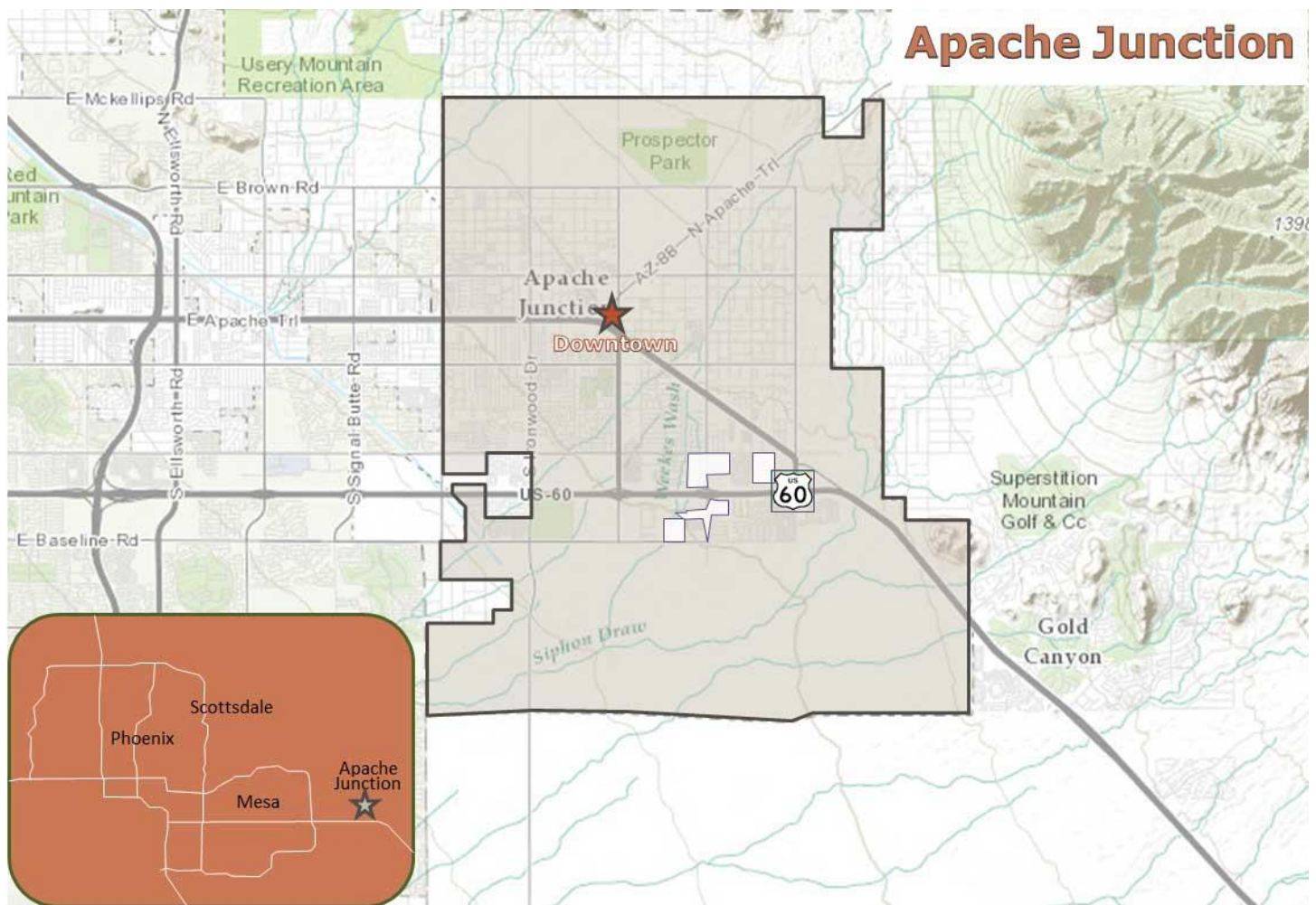

## Apache Junction

Apache Junction is easily accessible to all Phoenix Valley cities via US-60. The US-60 freeway intersects I-10, Loop 101, and Loop 202.

Distance to Apache Junction from major freeway interchanges:

- 24 miles from I-10 and US-60
- 18 miles from Loop 101 and US-60
- 4 miles from Loop 202 and US-60.



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
